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Key Eligibility Criteria

- The nominee must be an individual or organization.
- An individual nominee must be alive at the time of application and at least 18 years old.
- The nominee must have existing and documented works or initiatives in the field of coexistence and tolerance.
- The works must be implemented or under implementation, and must not be merely future ideas.
- The work or initiative must have been ongoing for no less than one year.
- Funding must be legal and compliant with ethical standards.
- The work must not be directed toward achieving political gains or objectives.
- The works must comply with the principles of justice and human values.
- The nominated organization must be an existing legal entity whose legal status can be verified.
- The nominee must have a sound professional and ethical record that aligns with the values of the Award and preserves its integrity and credibility.

What Does the Award Recognize?

The Award recognizes works and initiatives that achieve a tangible impact in one or more of the following areas:



Strengthening mutual respect, understanding, and cooperation among different religions, cultures, and communities



Countering hate speech, extremism, violence, intolerance, and discrimination



Promoting social cohesion, positive engagement, and coexistence



Presenting innovative models, policies, or solutions that are sustainable, scalable, or applicable in other contexts



Developing educational, awareness-raising, or community programs that support a culture of coexistence and tolerance
